

RULES

- A. The agenda will be followed unless the Chairman determines otherwise.
- B. All persons in attendance must sign the attendance book located at the entry indicating whether you are a shareholder and whether you are a representative of a company.
- C. Only shareholders of record, persons holding proxies from shareholders of record, and beneficial owners of Company shares held in street name will be permitted to address the meeting. Beneficial owners of street name shares may be required to present proof of their status.
- D. If you wish to speak, please raise your hand. You must use the microphone provided and must address any question, or point of order to the Chairman. To be recognized, you must state your name and state whether you are a shareholder of record, proxy holder or owner of shares held in street name.
- E. You may not speak for more than three minutes on any topic, and you may not address the meeting on more than three topics without leave from the Chairman. All remarks and questions must reasonably relate to the Company or its business. Personal remarks or political remarks or other inappropriate or irrelevant remarks will be ruled out of order. Roberts Rules of Order will not be applicable.
- F. Questions and discussion will be limited to the agenda item then on the floor. During the "New Business" segment, the Chairman will recognize shareholders who have statements or questions relevant to the Company or its business. All questions must be addressed to the Chairman. No shareholder submitted a proposal for consideration at this meeting in accordance with the Bylaws of the corporation, and accordingly no proposal other than those set forth in the proxy statement will be entertained at this meeting.
- G. The Company is recording the proceedings. No photographic equipment or other recording devices are permitted. No smoking, please. Please turn off cell phones and pagers.
- H. The Chairman of the Meeting has the authority to run the meeting in an orderly fashion and to ensure compliance with California laws relating to lawful assemblies.
