I write on behalf of Plaintiff to respectfully request a ten (10) day extension of time, from May 26, 2020 until June 5, 2020, to file Plaintiff's Opening Brief in Support of the Settlement of the above-captioned action (the "Action"), and the application for attorneys' fees and expenses (the "Opening Brief").

Pursuant to the Scheduling Order entered by the Court on May 12, 2020 (the "Scheduling Order"), the Opening Brief is due to be filed on May 26, 2020, with the Final Approval Hearing scheduled for August 11, 2020. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, any objection must be served and filed no later than June 26, 2020. *Id.* at ¶

8. Therefore, if the Court grants Plaintiff's request, any class member who wishes

to file an objection would still have Plaintiff's Opening Brief three (3) weeks before objections would be due. Moreover, Plaintiff notes that the prior objector Fair Value Investments, Inc., whose counsel is copied below, has been in possession of the revised Stipulation of Settlement since May 8, 2020.

Plaintiff's counsel have consulted with Defendants' counsel, and have been informed that Defendants take no position on the requested extension. Should Your Honor have any questions, counsel are available at the Court's convenience.
